

As part of the on-going HCUP quality management program, we discovered duplicated records in the 2006–2012 South Carolina State Emergency Department Databases (SEDD). The purpose of this notification is to provide a description of the issue and instructions on how to identify and remove the duplicated records.

## **Data Issue**

The 2006–2012 South Carolina SEDD included duplicated ED records with very similar, if not identical information. The duplication was inadvertently caused during the creation of the HCUP SEDD and therefore impacted all types of emergency department records. The duplicated records were not specific to certain hospitals or types of conditions with one exception. In data year 2012 only, there were duplicated ED visits that also involved observation services.

## How to Identify and Remove the Duplicate Records

The table below lists the number of records in each year of the South Carolina SEDD, the number of duplicated records, and how to identify and remove the duplicated records for each data year.
